## Programming Options

### EARLY INTERVENTION AND PROGRAM UNIT FUNDING (PUF) CRITERIA

Does your child have limited verbal language? Do they struggle to understand what others are saying to them? Do they have a medical diagnosis?

PUF is available for children with exceptionalities who are between the ages of 2 years 8 months and 4 years 8 months by September 1st.

### MILD MODERATE CRITERIA

Does your child have mild to moderate verbal communication delays? Can they sometimes be difficult to understand?

Programming is available for children who are experiencing mild to moderate delays and are at least 3 years 8 months as of September 1st.

**Children must meet criteria from Alberta Education to be eligible for PUF or Mild Moderate programming.**

### COMMUNITY PALS

Are you looking for a play-based educational setting for your child to gain independence and have opportunities for social interactions? Programming is available for students who are 3 years 8 months as of September 1st who have no diagnosed difficulties or delays.

**Our priority is to ensure that all children experience success and have their individual needs met through play and quality learning experiences!**

Children who participate in early learning programming are immersed in a language rich setting that encourages independence, self-awareness and social interaction. ## Our Programs

Programs will be offered at multiple locations, including CW Sears in Tofield as well as in select schools in Camrose.

### PROGRAM HOURS:

- Community Pals will attend 3 days per week for 3 hours per day for 339 hours total.
- Students who qualify for PUF will attend four days per week for 400 hours total.
- Students who have Mild-Moderate delays will attend four days per week with some additional programming days for a total of 475 hours.

### FEES

- There is a \$100.00 deposit that will be applied to your first month's fee.
- Fees for students not receiving PUF funding will be \$295.00 per month.
