Binders: three 1½-inch binders (3-ring, hard plastic, no zipper, no flaps) <input type="checkbox"/> 4. Dividers: 20, hard plastic <input type="checkbox"/> 5. Erasers: 2 white <input type="checkbox"/> 6. Facial tissue: 1 box <input type="checkbox"/> 7. Glue stick: 1 small stick <input type="checkbox"/> 8. Headphones with microphone <input type="checkbox"/> 9. Highlighters: 4, assorted colours <input type="checkbox"/> 10. Lunch kit <input type="checkbox"/> 11. Page protectors: 4, clear plastic <input type="checkbox"/> 12. Paint/work shirt: oversized for messy work, art projects, etc. <input type="checkbox"/> 13. Ziploc Slider Extra Large Heavy-Duty Freezer Bag or similar: 1, to protect library books and important documents during transport to and from school
